

- → Initial formation based on discussions among:
 - Packard Foundation
 - Surfrider Foundation
 - Ocean Foundation
 - → NOAA Coastal Services Center
- → These groups recognized a need to better align & connect EBM activities they supported
- → Began by identifying 6 existing locally-based EBM initiatives to begin Network

Network History, cont.

- → Six groups first met February 2008 in San Francisco, CA
- + First Annual Meeting in October 2008, Friday Harbor, WA
- → Network Coordinator hired January 2009
- → Second Annual Meeting to be held Summer Fall 2009
- → Initial support provided by Packard Foundation; project housed by Tides Center
