







Collaborative Research Project: September Update

THANK YOU TO OUR VOLUNTEER ANGLERS FOR ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL MONTH!!

Rick Starr of the UC Cooperative Extension Sea Grant Program and Moss Landing Marine Laboratories and Dean Wendt of California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo have been working with Commercial Passenger Fishing Vessels and recreational anglers to catch and tag fish out of Monterey, Morro Bay, Pillar Point and San Luis Harbors. The purpose of this collaborative research is to collect baseline information about the Point Buchon, Point Lobos, and Año Nuevo Marine Protected Areas (MPAs). This Fall we are fishing two days per month inside each of these MPAs and two days per month in reference areas outside the MPAs.

In August, our first month of sampling, we went out for 12 days and caught a total of 3,668 fishes (all three areas combined). In September, we fished 11 days and caught 2,574 fishes. We saw a variety of fish species in September, including: Black, Black-and-Yellow, Blue, Brown, Canary, China, Copper, Gopher, Grass, Kelp, Olive, Rosy, Starry, Treefish, Vermilion, and Yellowtail rockfishes, Cabezon, Kelp and Rock Greenling, Lingcod, Mackerel, sardines, and a Red Irish Lord.

We want to thank all of the volunteer anglers who fished with us this past month, and the captains and deckhands of the F/V Caroline, Fiesta, Huli Cat, Pacific Horizon and Patriot. Your expertise and interest is extremely valuable! We would like to acknowledge a few anglers who have come out with us multiple times during the past two months: Nancy and Gary Aubuchon, Sean Crandal, Ido Nienhuis and Matt Michie: 4 times; Darrell Bunse and Jim Dull: 6 times; David Reins: 8 times; and David Kammerer: 10 times!
